Band (Mr. Busch-Director of Bands)

- Solo/Ensemble will be held March 5, 2022 and we are going to need a lot of Parent Volunteers to help throughout the day. There will be a volunteer sign up that will be online soon, so please look for it.

- We have been given permission to ask the school board for permission to submit an audition tape for the Tournament of Roses 2024. This will be a music department trip meaning it would be for choir and band students. The choir would have their own event to participate in while the marching band marches in the Parade.
- Pep band will be performing at Corner Stone hockey arena game on January 28 from 7:30-8pm pre game.
