Booster Trip payments: Margaret Winkelman brought up that there are not very many more payments for the Disney trip. As a Booster club we need to decide what we are going to cover cost wise. If one payment is made for each student, it would be \$28,346. Joanne Widi asked if we could consider making two payments for each student since we have such a large amount in the money market account. The cost for two payments made for each student would be \$56,692. The only other expense we are being asked to cover is the cost of the trip T-shirts. Rachel Cheney made a motion to use the funds from the money market account to make the final two payments of the Disney trip. Nikki Love seconded the motion and a vote was taken. Everyone present was in favor with no one opposed. Motion passes. It was decided that the Boosters would cover the December and January payment for all students.
