This month: The Resch Center fundraising opportunities

WHAT is it: An opportunity to work in a concession stand at a Resch Center event. Events range from concerts, Blizzard games, Gambler games, Disney events, and much, much more! Check the PMB website for more information.

WHERE: The Resch Center in Green Bay

WHEN: approximately 4-5 hour shifts depending on event, usually evenings but sometimes during the day. The Sign Up is always posted in the newsletter and on the website for easy access.

WHY? To earn money for both YOUR individual student(s) accounts and the PMB account which helps pay for trips, awards, program equipment, camps & MORE! You're support through fundraising is very valuable to the success of the Pulaski Music Program!!

HOW MUCH is earned? \$10-12/hour base wage plus tips = Total range \$14-24/hour (2023 figures). 80% of base wage goes to your individual student's account(s) and 20% goes to the PMB. Tips are disbursed quarterly based on total tip amount and total hours worked by everyone in that quarter and are also split 80/20 between Student Account and PMB.

WHAT will I be doing? bringing food/drink to customers, running a cash register (The Resch has a very easy system), prepping food, grilling to name a few.

ADDITIONAL PERKS:

*you are able to enjoy the remaining event when your shift is complete.

*You are able to enjoy any food not sold at the end of the night once inventory is complete (burgers, hot dogs, pretzels, pizza etc).

*You are able to take a sneak peak at the entertainment when your stand is not busy.

*You are able to bring a friend, spouse, grandparent, and even your child if age 16 and over (Must be age 18 to serve/sell alcohol but they can serve food) and ALL of your hours will be raising monies toward your student's account and the PMB.

*You are able to start raising money when your child is in 8th grade for their high school music trips.

*When a student graduates/leaves the music program, remaining student account balances can be passed to another sibling entering the program.
